



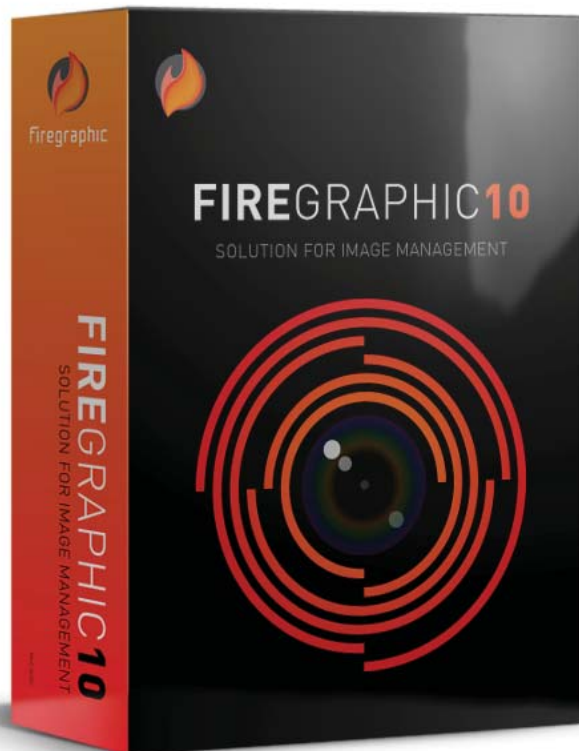

## CONNECTING A DIGITAL CAMERA TO YOUR COMPUTER AND IMPORT PHOTOS



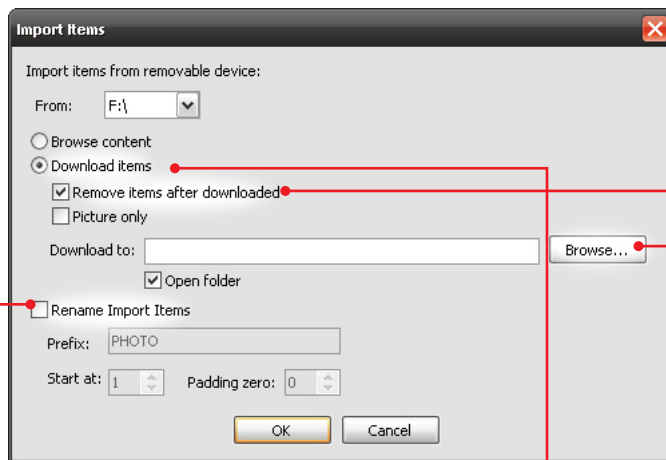
Before you can organize and edit your photos, you need to import them from your digital camera to your computer. During import, you can choose to rename the photos and put them into a specific folder. When the import is completed, your photos are renamed in the folder you chose and ready to browse and edit.

## To connect a digital camera:

1. Set your camera to the correct mode for importing photos.
2. Plug the USB cable into your computer USB port and the camera.
3. If your camera is not on, turn it on. It should be detected by Firegraphic automatically.

## To import photos:

1. With Firegraphic opened, connect your camera to your computer as instructed above.
2. Firegraphic should detect your camera and open the Import Items dialog box.



3. In the Import Items dialog box, check the **Download item(s)** option.
4. If you want to delete the photos from you camera/memory card after they are imported to your computer, check the **Remove items after download.**
5. Click the **Browse** button to select the location where you want to save the photos. Check the **Open folder** option if you want Firegraphic to open the folder with the imported photos when import is completed.
6. You can also rename all the photos during import. Simply check the **Rename Import Items** option and enter a name for the photos.
7. Click **OK** to start importing your photos.

If the Import Items dialog box does not show up after you've plugged the camera to your computer:

Go to **File → Acquire**, and choose the **Removable Drives** option to open the Import Items dialog box.
